COURSE OUTLINE

Learners must successfully complete a total of six units, including four core specialist modules and two elective options selected from the designated list.

SPECIALIST UNITS

- Business IT Project – 20 Credits
- Computer Forensics and Incident Investigation - 20 Credits
- Ethical Hacking and Information Security Assessments - 20 Credits
- Network Security Threats and Defence Mechanisms - 20 Credits

ELECTIVE UNITS

- Analysis, Designs and Implementation - 20 Credits
- Artificial Intelligence - 20 Credits
- IT Project Management - 20 Credits
- Professional and Career Development in IT- 20 Credits

To complete the qualification a student must study and pass units to the total of 120 credits



WHAT'S NEXT?

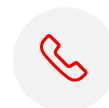
Graduates of the NCC Education Level 5 Diploma in Computing (with Cyber Security) are eligible to progress to final-year study through two key pathways:

- Enrol in the BSc (Hons) Cyber Security and Networking top-up degree, delivered online by NCC Education and validated and awarded by the University of Central Lancashire (UCLan).
- Alternatively, apply directly to Year 3 of a related university degree program in the UK or internationally.
